

Henderson Lake Park

The Heart of Recreation in Lethbridge, is located a block east of Mayor Magrath Drive on South Parkside Drive.

Henderson Park is a 47 hectare (117 acre) blend of relaxed leisure and active recreation opportunities concentrated around a 60 acre man-made lake. Paved and shale walking trails border Henderson Lake, along with playgrounds, rest areas and picnic sites. Concession is open during the summer months.

Henderson Park has been a focus of civic pride for more than 85 years. Originally developed for the 7th International Dry-Farming Congress in 1912, it continues to be an attraction for special event celebrations. The lake itself was originally a large slough. William Henderson, the Mayor of Lethbridge during the early preparations for the Farming Congress, was instrumental in initiating the concept of Henderson Lake and a surrounding park.



Park Amenities



Henderson Lake - A 24 hectare (60 acre) man-made lake provides boating and fishing opportunities from spring to fall.

Trails - Paved trails throughout Henderson Park connect the major facilities in the park. A variety of different users, including pedestrians, joggers, strollers, wheelchairs, cyclists and in-line skaters, frequent the trail around the lake (2.8 km) or around the perimeter of the entire park (4.3 km). The paved Coal Banks Trail runs through, and continues beyond, Henderson Park.

Group Picnic Shelters - The fenced, 10-pitch Henderson Horseshoes / Group Picnic Shelter and the Kiwanis Picnic Shelter may be booked for family parties and special events – call 320-3009.

The Kinsmen and Gunnery Point Picnic shelters are available on a first-come, first-served basis and no permit is required.
