What is the Yellow Fish Road Program?

- A program designed to help create awareness about the pollution that enters our storm drains, and that lead directly to the Oldman River!
- Painting yellow fish by storm drains as a visual reminder that “Rainwater Only” belongs in our storm drains.
- Hanging door hangers to create awareness in your neighbourhood.



Anything that is not rainwater:

- Affects the quality of our water.
- Creates a habitat that is hard for aquatic life to live in.
- Increases nutrients in the water, creating algal blooms.
- Is a type of non-point source pollution, which is pollution spread over a large area and not from one specific location or source; this type of pollution is hard to trace to its source.
