RISK MANAGEMENT

PURPOSE

The presence of a Risk Management Program that seeks to manage risk, promote the health and well being of our citizens, customers and employees, and avoid damage to property and the interruption of services is an ongoing corporate priority. The purpose of this policy is to provide a framework for administrative Risk Management policies in support of this goal.

POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of the City of Lethbridge to proactively reduce the risk of loss to people, property and processes. Therefore, administration will develop policies to ensure the obligations of government legislation are met and that systems and practices designed to assess and manage risk are established.

DEFINITIONS

- Special Purpose Body: means a City Council Committee or a Board, Commission or other body established under the legislative powers of the City of Lethbridge and includes any employees or volunteers of the Special Purpose Body. (See Appendix "B" for a list of Special Purpose Bodies).
