### **Part 1 – Introduction of the Issue**

- Here the issue is introduced to everyone in attendance.

### **Part 2 – Opinions of Councillors**

- The Mock Mayor will call on each of the Mock Councillors to provide their initial opinions on the issue.

### **Part 3 – Opening the Floor to Concerned Citizens Who Wish to Speak**

- The Mock Mayor will invite any concerned citizens up to the podium one by one to share their concerns and opinions.
  - Concerned Citizens have to present their concerns as quickly and clearly as possible.

### **Part 4 – Opening Up Debate**

- This part is where Mock Councillors will be able to voice their opinions, provide information and question the issue at hand.

### **Part 5 – Voting**

- After all debate and questions are answered, Mock City Council votes on the issue at hand.
  - The Mock City Clerk and Mock Mayor count the votes both for and against the issue.

### **Part 6 – Results**

- The results of the vote are read aloud.

### **Part 7 – Adjournment**

- This is when the meeting is officially over.

### **Part 8 – Media Scrum**

- The media may ask Mock City Council questions about the issue once the meeting is officially over.
