Westminster Area Redevelopment Plan

Proposal

- To have the Westminster Area Redevelopment Plan adopted by City Council.

What Does This Mean?

- The City of Lethbridge Planning and Development Services Department has developed a planning framework and supporting policies for the redevelopment of Westminster neighbourhood in accordance with stakeholder feedback, the Integrated Community Sustainability Plan / Municipal Development Plan (2010), and the Alberta Municipal Government Act.
- If adopted, the Plan will replace the current Westminster Area Redevelopment Plan, which was adopted in 1985.
- The Plan has been developed over four years of consultation and conversation with community stakeholders.
- The Plan complies with the South Saskatchewan Regional Plan and the Integrated Community Sustainability Plan / Municipal Development Plan.
