

Electrical Service Size Upgrades 100 Amp or larger July 26, 2011

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

As per Design Office:

In order to ensure that our design standards and electrical loading levels are being met, we require that the electrical design department is notified by the contractor of any increased loading level to an existing service. It is also required that the contractor notify the design department when any load greater than 100 amps is installed on a new residential service in order to ensure capacity.

Approval from the design department must be received prior to obtaining an electrical permit, as the service change may incur costs to the customer to upgrade the distribution system, and may also require a significant amount of time in order to update the system accordingly.
