HOW TO HELP

- ✓ Advocate for more affordable and accessible housing.
- ✓ Volunteer your time, or make a donation to social service agencies or outreach programs that provide food, clothing, shelter and other supports for people in need.
- ✓ Register for an Engaging Vulnerable Persons workshop with Alpha House Society.
- ✓ Participate in Downtown Safety Education Programming (organized through the Downtown BRZ) to learn how to improve the safety of your business/organization and to contribute to the overall safety of the community.
- ✓ Join a SAGE Clan community patrol to help provide food and supplies, and connect with vulnerable people in need of someone to talk with.
