

Traditional Blessing Ceremony for Scenic Drive North Construction

The Scenic Drive North project is located near traditional resources. Traditional resources include habitation sites, resource acquisition sites, sacred, religious, ceremonial sites, travel corridors, trails, landscape features associated with specific historical events and burial sites.

On June 30, 2011 a Traditional Land Use Assessment conducted by the Blood Tribal Government & External Affairs recommended a preconstruction ceremony be held prior to Construction.

The ceremony was held on May 22, 2012 and attended by the project personnel, senior officials from the City of Lethbridge and the Mayor. The ceremony was intended to bless the site, protect workers during construction, tribute to the ancestors; and protect future use of the road.
