

# Legacy Park Features – Phase 1

## Underground Servicing

- Deep and shallow utility installation and connection points for both current and future needs in the park

## Parking lots

- Phase 1 of parking lots will include about 200 stalls in 3 locations
- Driveway connections to streets and park entrances

## Basic Landscaping

- This includes the grading, installation of drainage and utility services for both current and future requirements
- Complete irrigation system installation
- Seed the turf
- Trees and shrubs
- Park furniture including benches, tables and trash receptacles
- Depot for staff and maintenance functions
- Fencing

## Pathways

- Primary pathway network to accommodate travel through the park and internal use of the park
- Tied into the existing and future growth of the pathway system functioning as a hub for both east/west and north/south pathway traffic

## Washrooms

- One washroom facility will be included in conjunction with the depot to serve the sport, playground and picnic area of the park

## Picnic Area

- The drop-in picnic area complete with covered picnic shelters

## Natural Wetland

- This area will consist of a naturalized pond used for skating and connect to the storm pond with a vegetated biological water filtering wetland creek

## Outdoor Ice Rink

- On the wetland shallow pond with access from the boardwalk and in close proximity to the future Community Pavilion building
- Includes winter water service to flood and maintain ice surface

## Nature Trails

- Trail along the wetland area including boardwalk for pond viewing and skating access

### Storm Pond

- Two section storm pond to provide storm water utility for the adjacent subdivision with naturalized edges.
- Functions as a water reservoir to supply irrigation water for park

### Playground

- One formal playground near picnic area and sport facilities

### Fitness Equipment

- Outdoor fitness equipment area near open space lawn area for yoga, tie chi or boot camp types of programming

### Sledding Hill

- Sledding hill designed for family use
- Hill functions as seating area for outdoor performances and entertainment
- Vantage point for viewing the park and the river valley

### Performance venue (outdoor)

- Belvedere structure to function as both an outdoor stage and a viewing platform over the water
- Funding partner with VASA Lodge

### Sport Fields

- Includes both ball and soccer fields for informal and community drop in use

### Open Lawn

- Lawn areas left open without obstructions and relatively flat to provide flexibility for a variety of activities

### Skateboard Park

- Designed to be an open plaza style of park that will provide the skate park features for the riders but integrate plaza types of use for spectators and other park users
- Designed to integrate into the park seamlessly rather than on overly defined structure modeled from The Forks in Winnipeg.

### Sports Courts

- Challenge Course – timed obstacle course race facility
- Basketball
- Pickleball
- Tennis
- Grass Volleyball

### Formal Garden

- Formal Garden in North-West area with landform and infrastructure installed to accommodate future garden development in partnership with the Lethbridge Horticultural Society
