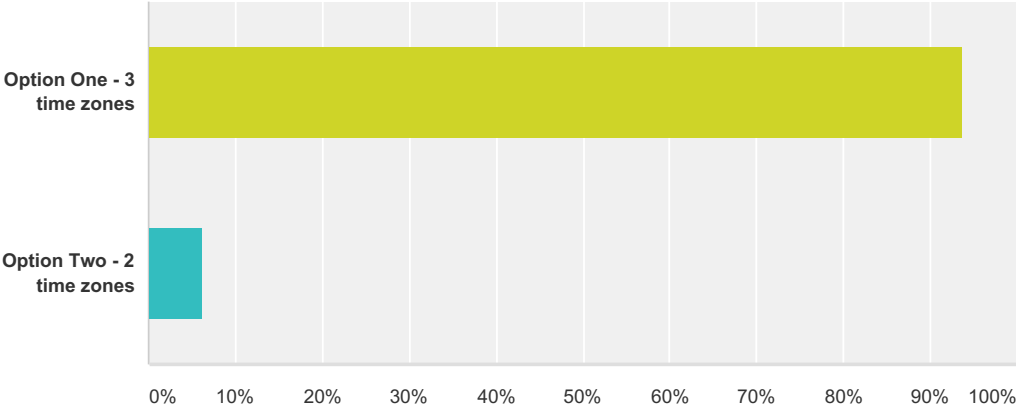


### Q1 1. Of the two time zone options presented, which do you prefer ?

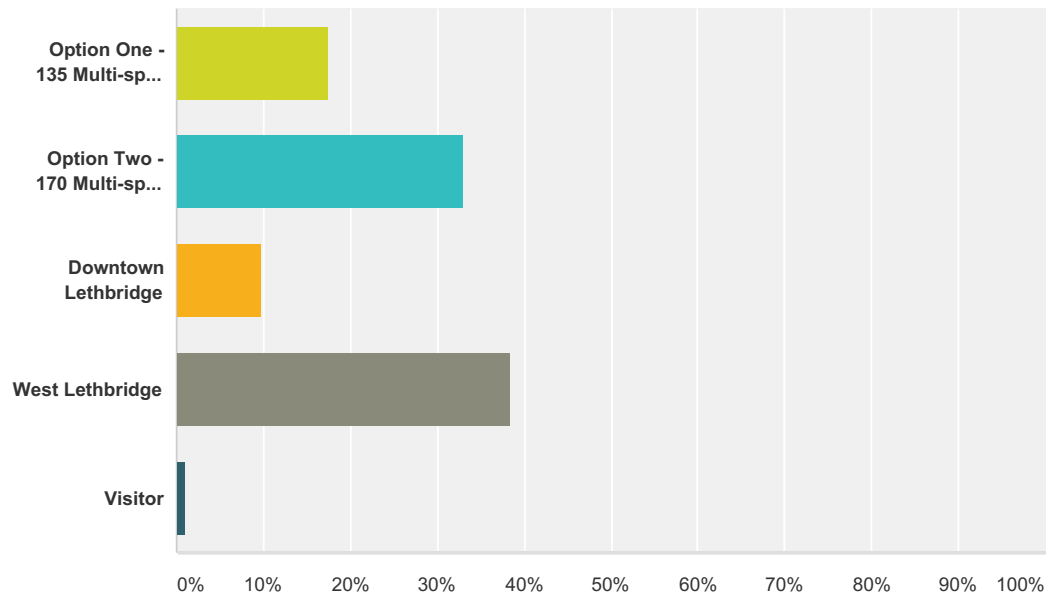

### Q2 2. Of the two machine placement options, which did your prefer ?

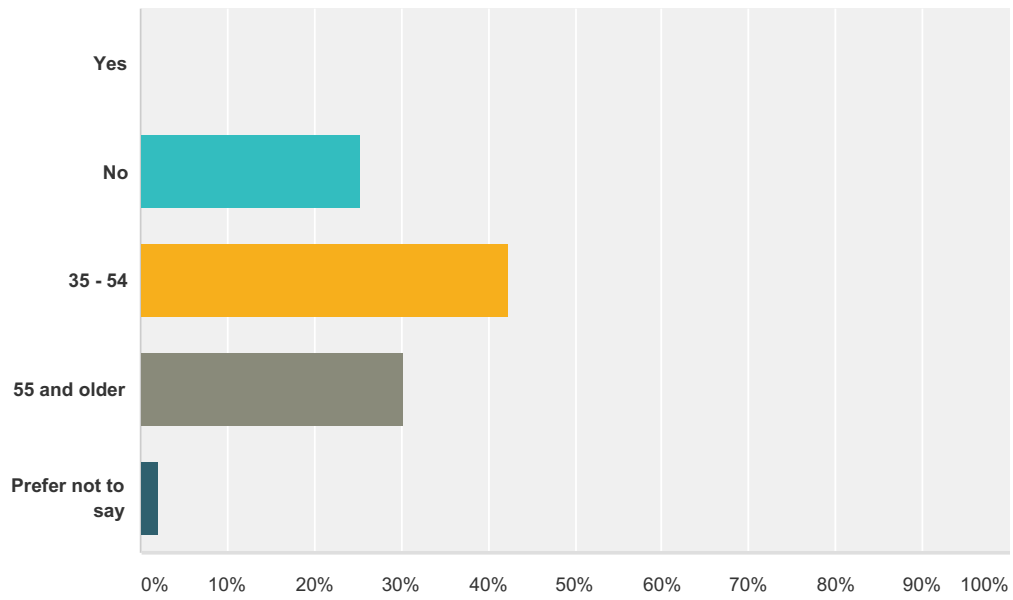

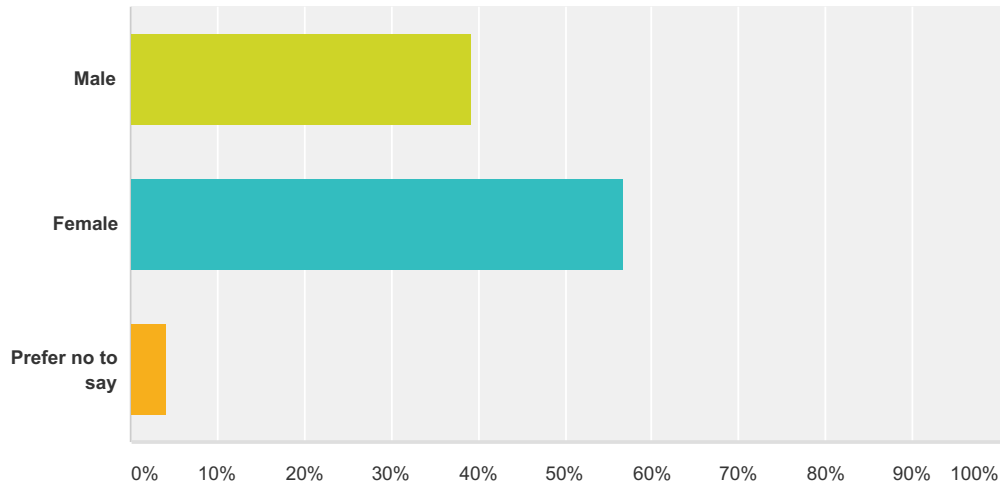

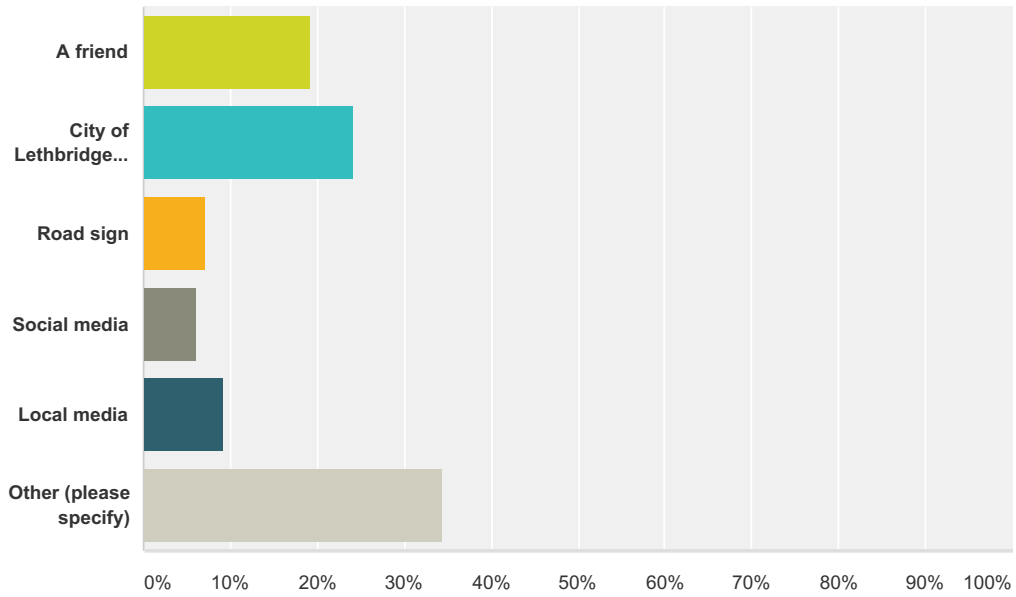

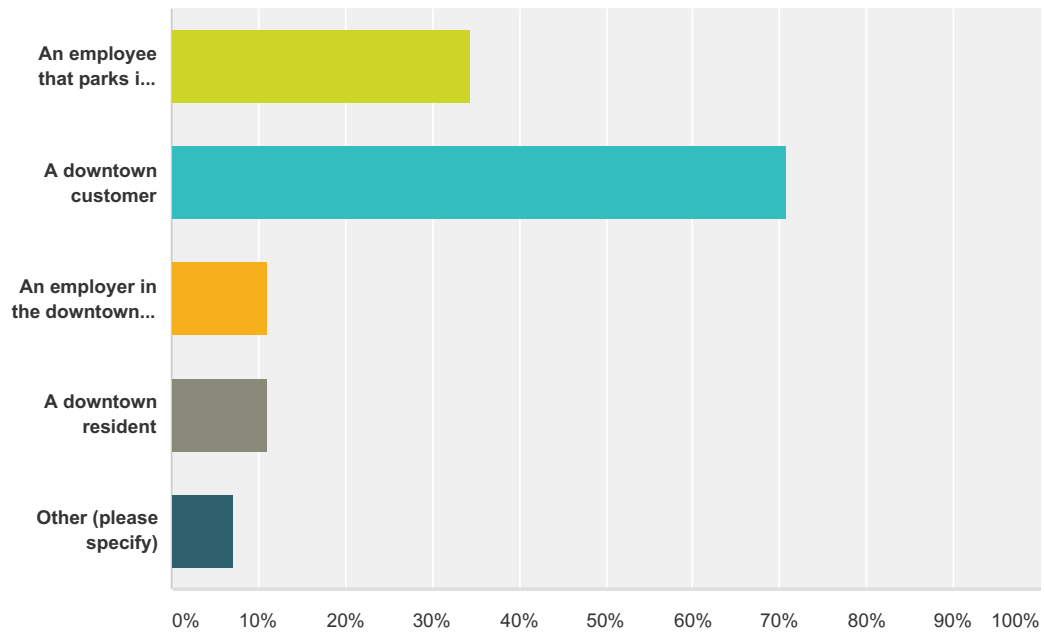

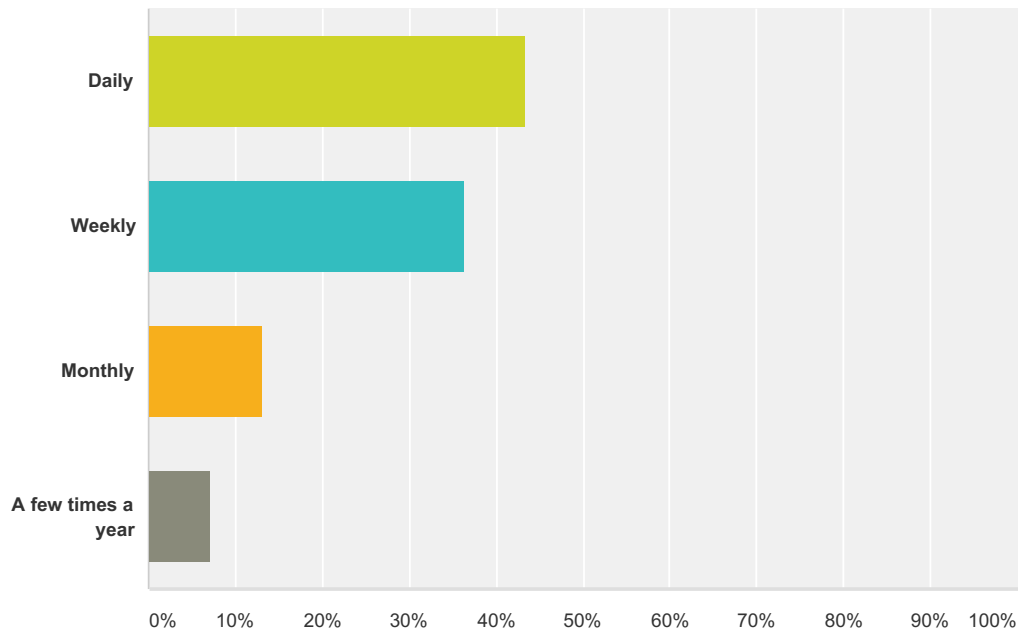

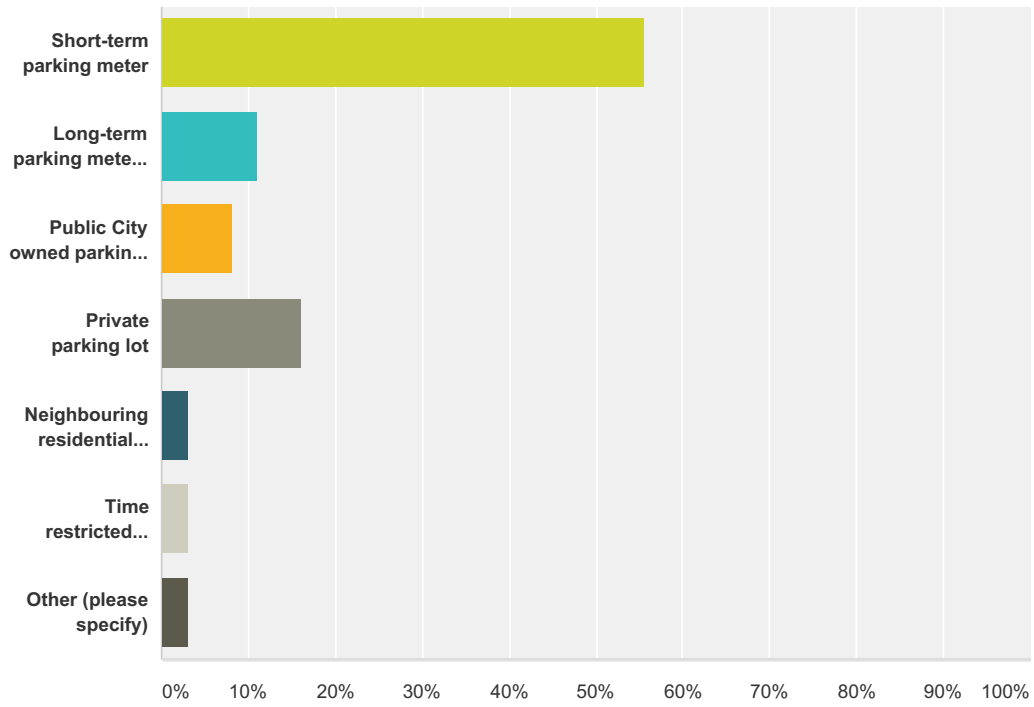

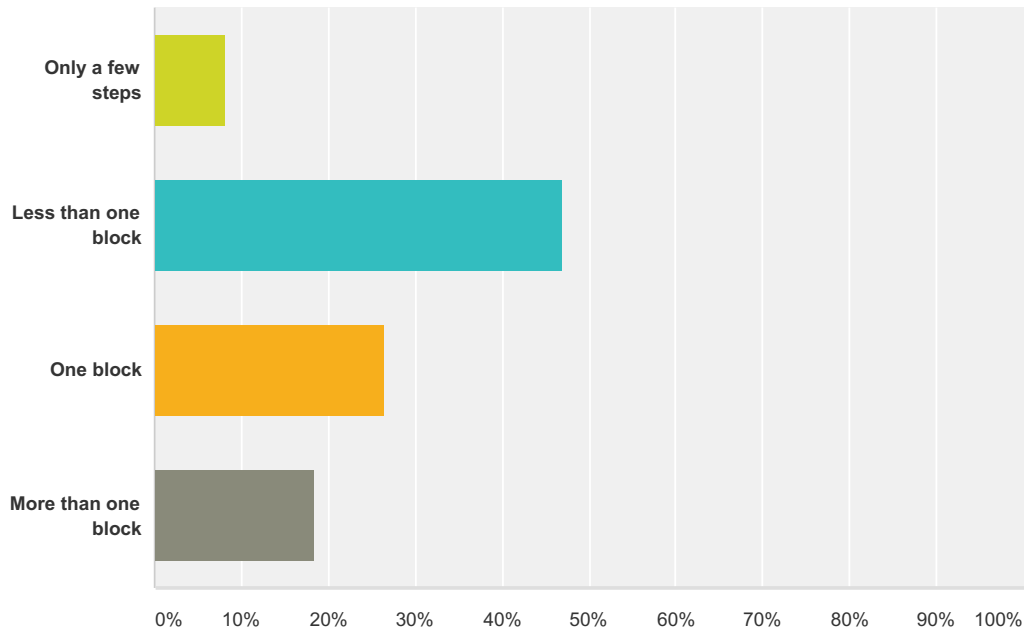

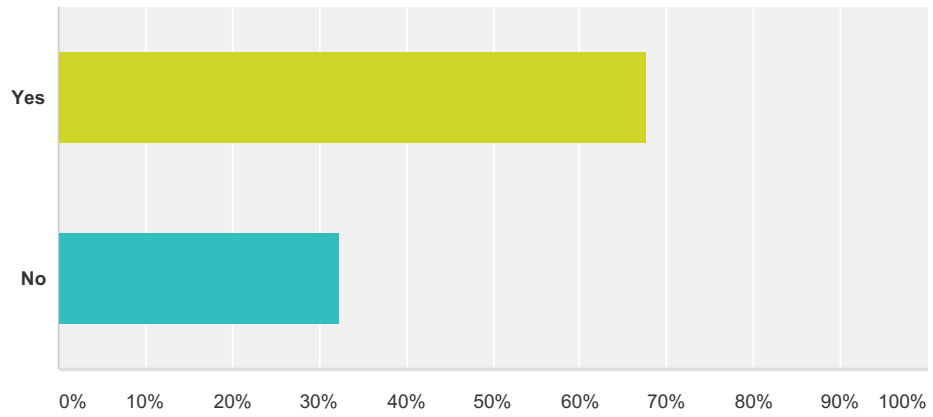

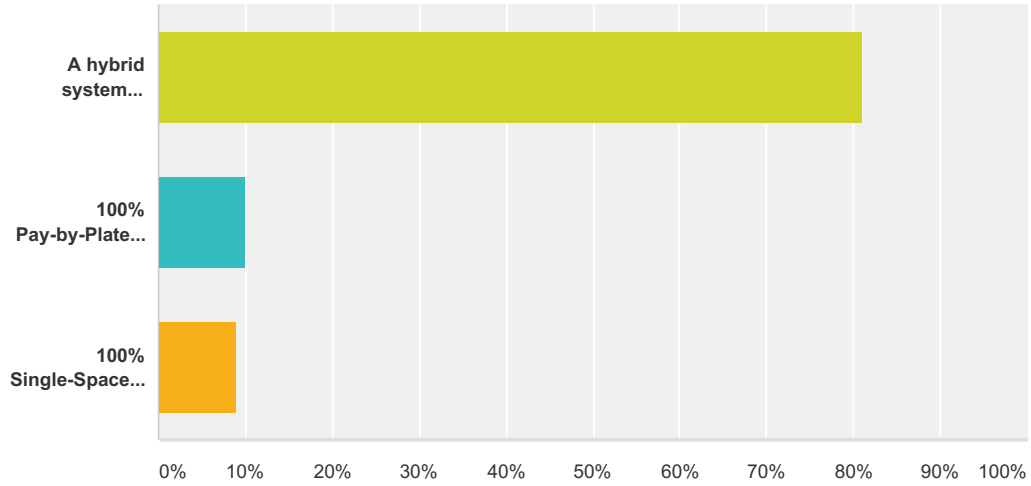

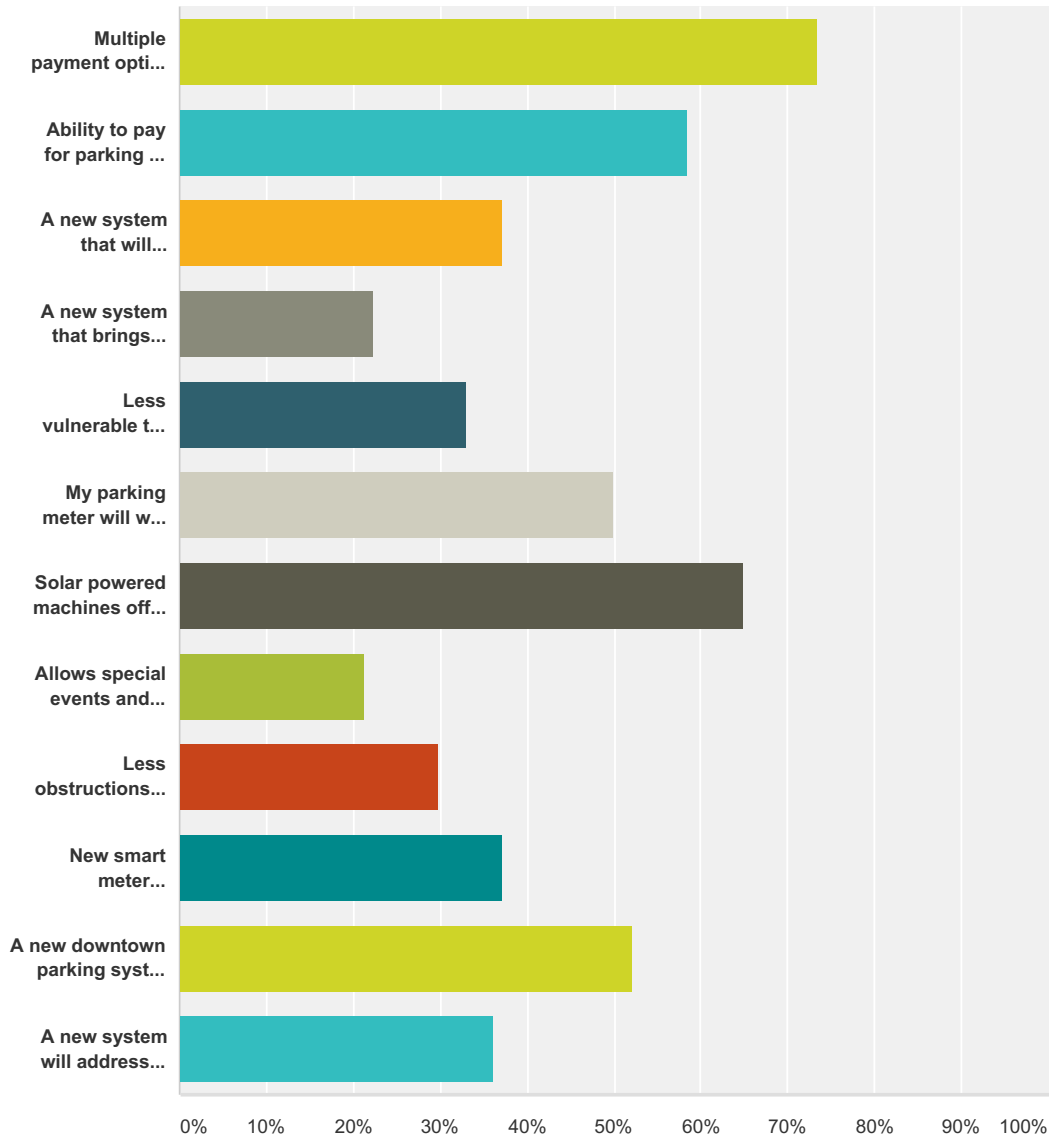
