Recreation & Culture: Rotary Picnic Shelter

INSTRUCTIONS: WIRELESS MICROPHONE (THE SHURE PG58)



- 1. Turn the Power Buttons on for the Microphone, Microphone Receiver and the Amplifier. If you are playing music, turn on the Power to the CD player and/or the Radio controller.
- 2. Adjust the Master Volume control dial to 5.
- 3. Adjust Dial #2 to no higher than 5.
- 4. On the microphone receiver, you will see a number such as A1 or C3. This is your receiver channel. The code on the microphone can be found by unscrewing the base of the microphone. You will see a digital code number flashing. E.g. A1, C3
- 5. You will need to ensure that the microphone is synced to this channel.
- 6. To do this, unscrew the bottom cover off the microphone.
- 7. Ensure the microphone has AA batteries.
- 8. Ensure microphone has been turned on. There will be a small green LED light showing that the microphone has been powered on.
 - a. There are two buttons labelled 'Group' & 'Channel' near the middle of the microphone.
 - b. Press the 'Group' button repeatedly until you reach the appropriate 'letter' to match the letter on the receiver. Eg. A or C.
 - c. Press the 'Channel' button repeatedly until your number matches the number on the receiver. Eg. 1 or 3.
- 9. Once you have matched up the codes, check the volume on the amplifier and conduct a sound check to see if the microphone is working.
- 10. Adjust the Master Volume or the microphone volume (Dial #2) to achieve the desired volume, (recommended setting is 5 or 6).
