

MAILING OF 2022 ASSESSMENT NOTICES

All 2022 Property Assessment Notices for residential, non-residential and multi-family residential units (4 units or more) have been mailed as of January 5, 2022.

Property owners signed up for eNotices would have received their assessment notice by email at the email registered to their MyCity account.

Complaints must be filed with the Assessment Review Board Clerk by 4:30 PM, March 14, 2022 to be accepted.

Complaints must include the appropriate complaint fee to be considered valid. Only cash, cheque or debit will be accepted. Credit cards will not be accepted. If an agent is representing you, the Agent Authorization form must be included with your complaint.
