## **BYLAW 6302**

## A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LETHBRIDGE TO REPEAL THE TEMPORARY MANDATORY FACE COVERINGS BYLAW

**WHEREAS** the City of Lethbridge enacted the Temporary Mandatory Face Coverings Bylaw on August 24, 2020 due to the presence of Covid-19 within the City of Lethbridge;

AND WHEREAS a vaccination for Covid-19 is now available to the public;

**AND WHEREAS** the Government of Alberta anticipates ending Covid-19 restrictions in its "Open for Summer" plan;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LETHBRIDGE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Bylaw 6239, the Temporary Mandatory Face Coverings Bylaw, is repealed by this bylaw.
- 2. This bylaw comes into force and effect upon third and final reading.
