

## **BARBEQUE INSTRUCTIONS:**

## **PLEASE NOTE:**

\*THIS BBQ IS EQUIPPED WITH AN AUTOMATIC FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEM.

\*THE DOOR NEEDS TO BE FULLY OPEN AND THE EXHAUST FANS NEED TO BE ON FOR THE GAS TO FLOW.

- 1. Unlock padlocks (Key 2310) at the bottom of the left and right side of the overhead door and pull the locking lever inwards.
- 2. Raise the overhead door by pulling on the chains on the right side of the door and hook the chains in the clasp.
- 3. DOOR MUST BE FULLY OPEN FOR THE BBQ TO OPERATE.
- 4. Check and make sure all gas control knobs are set to **OFF**. Horizontal position for grills/ griddles and vertical position for 4 open-burner top range.
- 5. Open main gas valve (Key 2105) on the outside of the west wall of the BBQ enclosure.
- 6. **TURN ON THE EXHAUST FANS**. The **GREEN START** button is located in the steel cupboard (Key 2310) on the west wall. Light switches are also located there.
- 7. To ignite any of the 4 open burners, turn gas knob to pilot and hold in while depressing red igniter button located in cabinet below, then turn gas knob to full **ON**.
- 8. Select which burners / griddles you wish to use. Turn gas control knob for that unit on and press igniter switch (you will hear a clicking sound until gas ignites). This may continue for a minute or so until ignition. Select other burners / griddle as desired, ignite the same way.
- 9. When finished, turn all gas control knobs to **OFF**, (horizontal for grills / griddles and vertical for 4 open-top range burners). Turn igniters to **OFF**.
- 10. Turn **OFF** the exhaust fans and lights. Close and lock cabinet.
- 11. Close main gas valve on the outside of the west wall of the BBQ enclosure and lock.
- 12. Close the overhead door with the chains, push the locking levers to the outside and attach the padlocks.
