CONSOLIDATION OF A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LETHBRIDGE TO ESTABLISH A TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM FOR THE CITY OF LETHBRIDGE

WHEREAS the Municipal Council for the City of Lethbridge has prepared Comprehensive Transportation Study Reports in accordance with Section 32 of the Highways Development and Protection Act for the development of an integrated transportation system designed to service the needs of the entire City of Lethbridge, the Transportation Study Reports consisting of the following:

- 1. "Transportation Master Plan" dated April 2013,
- 2. "West Lethbridge Employment Area Structure Plan" dated February 2013, and
- "Circulation Road Study" dated May 2010.

AND WHEREAS City Council, prior to second reading of this Bylaw, has caused notice of this Bylaw to be published at least once a week for two consecutive weeks in one or more newspapers having general circulation within the City, the last of such publications being at least FOURTEEN (14) DAYS before the date for the second reading of this Bylaw.

AND WHEREAS in consideration of this Bylaw City Council has duly heard and considered the representations presented either personally or through an agent of all interested parties at a public hearing of this Bylaw;


AND WHEREAS City Council deems this Bylaw to be in the public interest;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LETHBRIDGE, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This Bylaw shall be known as the "City of Lethbridge Transportation System Bylaw".
- In accordance with the Transportation Study Reports hereinbefore described, City Council hereby establishes a transportation system for the City of Lethbridge consisting of the following:
 - a. The Plan revised May 2013 and attached to this Bylaw entitled "Transportation System City of Lethbridge" and incorporated as part of this Bylaw as Appendix" A".
 - b. The schedule attached to this Bylaw entitled "Physical Description of Roadways" and incorporated as part of this Bylaw as Appendix "B".

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS, NAMELY:

- a. That the financial resources necessary for the construction of the said transportation system will be available to the City of Lethbridge.
- b. That the City of Lethbridge may amend this Bylaw from time to time by the addition or deletion of transportation facilities or in any other manner, subject to the approval of the Minister of Transportation.
- 3. Bylaw 5281 and amendments thereto is hereby repealed.
- 4. This Bylaw will come into force on the date that it is approved by the Minister of Transportation.

- 12) 3 Ave S, between Scenic Dr S and Mayor Magrath Dr S.
- 13) 6 Ave S, between Scenic Dr S and Mayor Magrath Dr S.
- 14) 10 Ave S, between 13 St S and Mayor Magrath Dr S.
- 15) South Parkside Dr S, between Mayor Magrath Dr S and 43 St S.
- 16) Whoop Up Dr, between Scenic Dr S and west corporate limits.
- 17) Garry Dr W, between University Dr W and Garry Station Port W.
- 18) Walsh Dr W, between University Dr W and the west corporate limits.
- 19) 24 Ave S, between Mayor Magrath Dr S and 43 St S.
- 20) Macleod Dr W from University Dr to McMaster Blvd W
- 21) Métis Trail W from Temple Blvd W to Whoop Up Dr W
- 22) Métis Trail W between Country Meadows Blvd W and Walsh Dr W

FUTURE ARTERIALS

- 1) Macleod Dr W from McMaster Blvd W to future Métis Trail W
- Métis Trail W from future Chinook Trail W to Temple Blvd W
- 3) Métis Trail W from Whoop Up Dr W to Country Meadows Blvd W
- 4) Métis Trail W from Walsh Dr W to north corporate limits
- 5) Chinook Trail W from Scenic Dr S to Walsh Dr W
