This is a small intimate park that borders on the coulee system to the North. The area has been noted for slumping, as such the park is 'Xeri Scaped' meaning that there is no additional water required to maintain the plant life, thereby not adding to the soil erosion.



The park is one of only a few in the city that have the Xeri Scaped feature. As a result of the Xeri Scaping native plant life is slowly encroaching into the park.

The park also has a colourful playground featuring a slide and climbing apparatus.



This park is near the shale trail system that leads down into the coulee and connects to Peenaquim Park (located in the Oldman River Valley).

Visitors to this park will most likely see deer, rabbits and other wildlife as they emerge from the coulee.
