Amendment to Bylaw 6265 - Municipal Development Plan



Proposal

- Proposed amendment to the City of Lethbridge Municipal Development Plan includes:
 - Amending MDP policy 104 & Appendix B regarding reserve land for future school sites.
- Applicant: Planning & Design Department

What Does This Mean?

- The purpose of the proposed amendment to the Municipal Development Plan is to align with recent changes in provincial legislation regarding how reserve land is taken and registered for future school sites. These are minor clerical amendments.
- When a new school is being planned, the "school site" refers to both the School Building Envelope (which includes only the school building itself, the parking lot, and the school playground), and the remaining land that is usually used for associated purposes such as sports fields for the community and/or school use. The proposed amendments would ensure that the land required for a School Building Envelope meets provincial requirements, and that any remaining reserve land not used for the School Building Envelope is likely to remain held as Municipal Reserve (MR) to be used for the needs of the community.
