### **Proposal**

- Administration-initiated text amendments to the above-noted bylaws, and others not requiring a public hearing, in order to eliminate references to the Municipal Planning Commission (MPC).

### **What Does This Mean?**

- Bylaw 6330 would amend the listed bylaws, along with 3 additional procedural bylaws.
- MPC would be dissolved, and decisions currently made by MPC would now be made by the Development Authority (administration), the Subdivision Authority (administration), or City Council.
- All decisions proposed to be made by administration that are currently subject to appeal would continue to be appealable.
