WHO CAN VOTE?

ALL ELIGIBLE VOTERS WHO ARE:

- A Canadian citizen; and
- 2 At least 18 years of age; and
- 3 A resident of Lethbridge; and
- Able to provide a piece of ID demonstrating your name and current address

STUDENTS

A student who attends an educational institution within or outside Alberta; temporarily rents accommodation for the purpose of attending an educational institution; and has family members who are resident in Alberta and with whom the student ordinarily resides when not attending an educational institution, is deemed to reside with those family members.





WHAT IF I CAN'T GET OUT TO A VOTING STATION?

YOU MAY BE ABLE TO VOTE:

At your Care Facility

The City of Lethbridge will be providing Voting Stations at a number of care facilities, designated seniors housing, or supportive living facilities. Voters who live in these locations will be visited by election workers. This service is only for residents of these facilities.

At your Home

If because of a physical disability, you are unable to attend a voting station, you may request to vote at your home on Election Day between the hours of 10 A.M. and 8 P.M.

IDENTIFICATION

You must complete an Elector Register Form at the voting station and provide either:

- One piece of identification issued by a Canadian government, whether federal, provincial or local, or an agency of that government, that contains a photograph of the person, the person's name and the address of the person's residence; OR
- One piece of identification from the list below that contains the person's name and current address

FORMS OF ACCEPTABLE ID

Government-issued documents:

- Alberta driver's licence or ID card.
- AISH card.
- Alberta Natural Resources (Conservation) card.
- Alberta Wildlife Identification Number (WIN) card.
- Canadian Forces identification card.
- Canadian pleasure craft operator card.
- Firearm possession and acquisition (PAL) licence.
- Fishing, trapping, or hunting licence.
- Government cheque or cheque stub.
- Income/property tax assessment notice.
- Letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee.
- Métis Nation of Alberta citizenship card.
- Métis Settlement membership card.
- Outdoors or wildlife card / licence.
- Statement of government benefits (e.g. employment insurance, old-age security, child tax benefits, etc.)

FORMS OF ACCEPTABLE ID (continued)

School, college or university documents:

Correspondence issued by a school, college or university.

Other documents:

- Bank/credit card statement or personal cheque.
- Insurance policy or coverage card.
- Pension Plan statement of benefits, contributions or participation.
- Residential lease or mortgage statement.
- Utility bill (e.g. telephone, public utilities commission, television, hydro (electric), gas or water).
- Vehicle ownership, registration or insurance certificate.
- Any other piece of identification authorized by the Chief Electoral Officer that contains both name and address.

Attestation form:

Attestation forms are authorized to be used as a form of identification in the following circumstances:

- A voter who resides in student housing on a campus.
- A voter who is renting their ordinary residence.

AT THE VOTING STATION:

Election workers will be there to help you move through the voting steps

1 SHOW YOUR IDENTIFICATION

2 READ, COMPLETE AND SIGN THE ELECTOR REGISTER FORM



RECEIVE YOUR BALLOTS

- Choose a Public or Separate School ballot
- An election worker will initial your ballots

4 GO BEHIND THE VOTING SCREENS TO MARK YOUR BALLOTS

- On each ballot, mark the box to the right of your chosen candidate(s) with an 'X'
- All other markings will not be accepted





CAST YOUR BALLOTS

Place your ballots into their designated ballot boxes
