

**Re: Bylaw No. 5423
Bylaw to Provide for the Assessment and Taxation
of Certain Otherwise Exempt Property**

The Municipal Government Act pursuant to Section 363 permits Council to tax certain exempt properties where Council considers it appropriate. In 1996 Council did so by passing Bylaw No. 4753. The enclosed Bylaw No. 5423 is simply an update to that initiative.

BYLAW NO. 5423

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LETHBRIDGE
TO PROVIDE FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND TAXATION
OF CERTAIN OTHERWISE EXEMPT PROPERTY

WHEREAS Section 363 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M.26 provides that a municipality may by bylaw make certain exempt properties subject to taxation to any extent considered appropriate.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LETHBRIDGE, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Tax Collector for the City of Lethbridge shall in the year 2006 and thereafter collect municipal tax portion from the following exempt properties in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Government Act.

(a) U of L Student Residences	2-0-700-4401-0002
(b) LCC Student Residences	1-0-113-3000-0004

2. Bylaw No. 4753 is hereby repealed.

3. This Bylaw shall come into effect on the date of final passage thereof.
